 The purpose of the meeting was set out – to decide the priorities for the APPG for Theatre.

Priorities for theatre in the UK

- SOLT and UK Theatre outlined UK Theatre's member priorities and business plan priorities and as a result suggested that during the first year, the APPG focuses on the following topics: theatre and the economy, workforce development. Access, diversity and inclusion run through all topics.
- SOLT and UK Theatre will draw up a terms of reference for each topic.
- SOLT and UK Theatre will draft a template letter for members to send to their MPs, inviting them to join the APPG.

Visits to theatres

- Visits to theatres arranged as part of the APPG will be in line with the first two priority topics.
- Separately, SOLT and UK Theatre will encourage theatres across the UK to invite their local MPs to visit them.

Structure of APPG meetings

- It was agreed that there would be 3-4 APPG meetings per year, where speakers would be invited in to give evidence on topics.
- It was agreed that the output of the two priority topics are written as reports to share with DCMS, DfE any other relevant departments.

• It was noted that this APPG has notified other relevant APPGs of its registration and would like to work with them where appropriate.

Theatre APPG Launch Event

• It was agreed that the launch event will take place in Autumn and will feature one or more performances and external speakers from the commercial sector and regional theatre.
