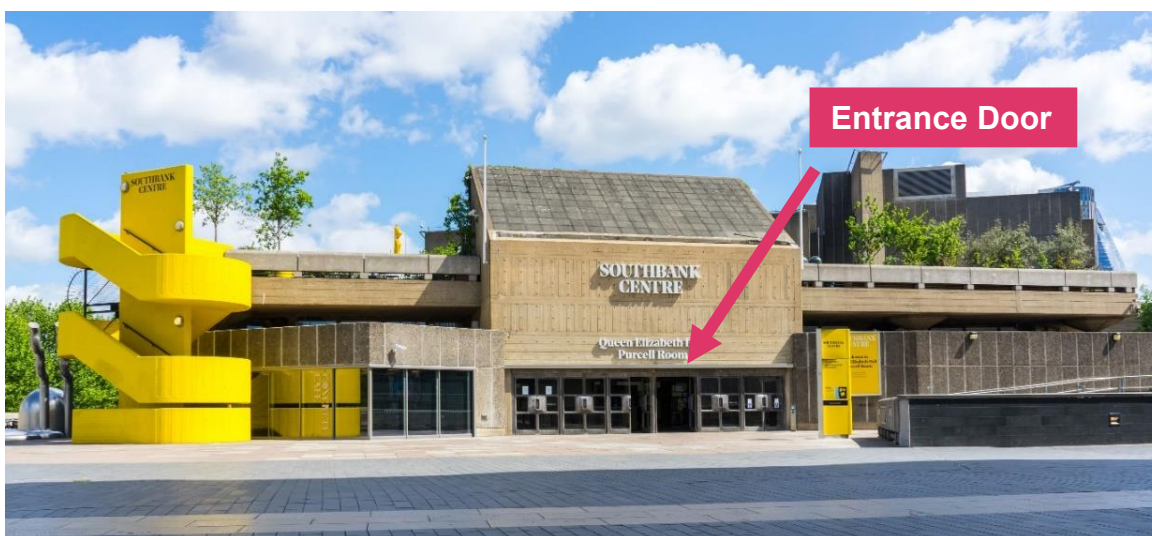

The Theatre Conference 2025 will take place at The Queen Elizabeth Hall, Southbank Centre.



- The Queen Elizabeth Hall and Purcell Room are fully accessible by wheelchair. Download step-free access [map and directions](#) for The Southbank Centre. Further accessibility information available from [The Southbank Centre](#)
- Blue badge parking is available, please do advise the team if you haven't already so we can let the venue know.
- Both the Queen Elizabeth Hall and Purcell Room have allocated seating for wheelchair users.
- There will be two BSL interpreters attending each session.
- Captioning will be available for all sessions.
- Hearing loops are available in both conference rooms. Please see [QEH Hearing Assist](#).
- A quiet room is available, please ask the registration desk and someone will escort you to Dressing Room 9.
- The Artists Bar, equipped with a Microwave & Sink, is available to those who are breastfeeding / expressing.
- We have an advised meeting point for the buddy system and those meeting colleagues. This on your left at the foyer entrance and past the bar.

Getting Here:

Nearest Tube Stations:

- Waterloo (Northern, Bakerloo, Jubilee and Waterloo & City lines) is 200 metres away.
- Embankment (District and Circle lines) is 600 metres away.

Travel by Bus:

- Routes 1, 26, 59, 68, 76, 139, 168, 172, 176, 188, 243, 341, 521, N1, N68, N171, N343 and X68 stop on Waterloo Bridge (100 metres away).
- Routes 76, 77, 211, 381, 507 and N381 stop on York Road (500 metres away).

Level Access:

There is level access to the Queen Elizabeth Hall via the external 24hr glass lift at the Royal Festival Hall Artist entrance on Southbank Centre Square. The lift will lead out to Mandela Walk. Continue straight when coming out the lift and take a right opposite Las Iguanas, you will see the Queen Elizabeth Hall entrance directly in front.



Alternatively, from the Queen Elizabeth Hall slip road off Belvedere Road (Near Blue Badge parking) the Royal Festival Hall JCB Glass Lift will be available between the hours of 10am-6pm. Select level 2 and make your way out onto Riverside Terrace and the QEH Entrance will be on your right.
